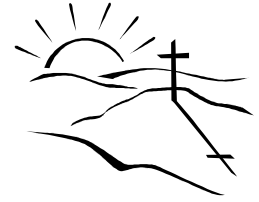




Sugar Creek Bible Camp

Dear Camper (and Parents/Guardians),

Welcome to summer camp at Sugar Creek Bible Camp! We look forward to having you join us for a week or more in the beautiful bluffs and valleys of Sugar Creek. Please read the following information carefully to help you prepare for a great week at camp! Enclosed in this envelope you will find a parent/camper profile questionnaire, a health history (physical) form and your registration deposit receipt. Examine all the information carefully and **verify your week of camp**. Please complete the enclosed forms, have the physical form signed, and return them to camp.

Your registration fee balance is **due by June 1, 2012**; however, we greatly appreciate early payments! Please mark this important date on your calendar and send any church campership funds by June 1 as well. If you would like to make payments toward your balance, e-mail: kati@sgrcreek.org or call the camp office: 608-734-3113 to set up a plan. You may send one check to cover all your children's fees or pay by credit card. You **MUST** call us to cancel your week at camp: **there are no deposit refunds for cancellations after June 1, 2012**. Arrival and Departure Times: Please arrive for registration between **2:00-4:00pm on the Sunday** of your camp week. Families are invited to tour the camp via horse-drawn wagon ride during this time. If you will be late, please call ahead to let us know. **Please, no early arrivals** as our counselors are busy preparing for their campers up until 2:00pm. Parents and family are welcome to attend our closing program on **Friday at 2:00 pm**. **Please allow time to park and walk**. If you plan to pick up your child before 2:30pm on Friday, you must complete an early release form at Sunday check-in. If you do not attend the closing program, plan to pick up your camper(s) no later than 2:30pm. **PLEASE BE PROMPT!** Be sure to check your children's luggage thoroughly before you depart and claim the correct sleeping bag and pillow. Also, please check *the Lost and Found table* before you go: many valuable items are left behind! Call the camp ASAP if your child is missing any items.

Pilgrims ONLY Times: *3rd and 4th grade, 1/2 week program*



Campers attending Sunday to Tuesday arrive Sunday between 2:00-4:00pm during our regular camper registration time. Tuesday departure is at 6:00pm with a short program for families. **PLEASE BE PROMPT!** **Campers attending Wednesday to Friday** arrive Wednesday at 9:00am. Departure is Friday at 2:30pm after the campers participate in our regular closing program at 2:00pm. **PLEASE BE PROMPT!**

First Aid & Medications: Sugar Creek always has a qualified first aid person on staff. If your child takes any medications, bring the meds **in the original container** with directions for use. All meds will be collected and dispersed by the First Aid provider, including non-prescription drugs and vitamins. Inhalers are an exception.



Phone Calls: Parents, do not promise your camper that s/he may call you from camp or that you will call. In case of emergency or severe homesickness, the Director will call you to discuss the situation.

Money: At check-in, campers may "bank" money for the canteen and Arts & Crafts. Canteen items, such as juice, snacks, etc. range in price from \$.25 to \$1.50. Most on-site campers visit the canteen daily. Major Art & Crafts projects range from \$1.00 to \$5.00 per project. Unspent money will be returned on Friday or can be donated. *Sugar Creek T-shirts, sweatshirts, hats, etc. may be purchased during Sunday arrival and Friday departure times.*



Packing for Camp: Bring only the essentials. TRAVEL LIGHTLY! (Especially Riverboaters, Voyageurs and Up North campers!) Pack old clothing that can get DIRTY! **Label everything with your name and phone number.** Parents, please send a checklist to help with end-of-the-week packing. Pack the following items in an easy-to-carry travel bag:

Bible - If you do not have a Bible we will gladly give you one!



Raincoat or Poncho - Campers participate in activities rain or shine.



Personal Items - Bring travel-size shampoo, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, a towel, etc.

Flashlight - Pack a small inexpensive flashlight and extra batteries.

Shoes - Sneakers/hikers for everyday use, sandals for the pool, and boots/sturdy shoes for horse rides. Strap-on sandals (*not flip flops*) or old shoes are needed for creek stomping.

Sleeping Bag - Bring a WARM, outdoor-use, sleeping bag, or blankets and a bag, and your pillow.

Bug Repellent/Sunscreen - Pack a small bottle of each to protect your camper. ☺



Warm Clothes-Evenings at camp are often cool, so please pack a sweatshirt or a light jacket, and long pants and socks. You **must** have a pair of long pants to wear on horseback rides.

Summer Wear - Pack comfortable clothes for warm, daytime activities.

Backpack- A backpack or bag is helpful for day trips, overnights, carrying things around camp...

Camera - One-time-use-cameras are best for camp, labeled with your name and phone number.

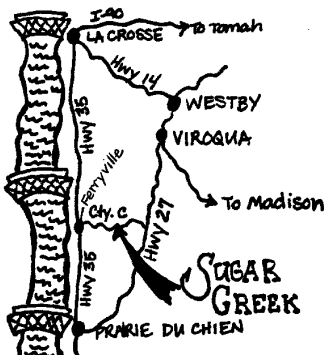


Swim Suit - Girls may wear one-piece swimsuits or Tankini suits: boys need to wear swim trunks.

No bikinis or Speedo briefs are permitted. This policy applies to ALL CAMP PROGRAMS.



PLEASE DO NOT BRING: Firearms, fireworks, hunting or other knives, pets, tobacco products, non-prescription drugs, radios, personal tape, CD, MP3, or **I-pod players**, **cell phones**, walkie talkies, food, alcohol or drugs. Campers found with alcohol or drugs will be dismissed from camp.



From LaCrosse: Hwy 35 south to County Rd C (just south of Ferryville). Turn left onto Cty C and drive 6 miles until you see the *Sugar Creek Bible Camp* sign. Turn right onto Sugar Creek Bible Camp Rd and drive across the bridge to the lower parking area.

From Prairie Du Chien: Hwy 35 north to County Rd C (just south of Ferryville). Turn right onto Cty C and drive 6 miles until you see the *Sugar Creek Bible Camp* sign. Turn right onto Sugar Creek Bible Camp Rd and drive across the bridge to the lower parking area.

From Viroqua: Hwy 27 South to County Rd C. Turn right on Cty C and drive 3 miles to camp. Turn left before the *Sugar Creek Bible Camp* sign on Sugar Creek Bible Camp Rd, drive across the bridge to the lower parking area.
