Leadership

The program is focused on raising up leaders, and we hope SIT-LITs go on to serve as leaders at camp and in their congregations. Our training uses well-respected leadership ideas and curricula.

Community

As part of a small team of SIT-LITs, each participant experiences the power of Christian community. They learn from, challenge, and teach one another while growing in their faith.



Mentorship

Summer staff and church professionals mentor SIT-LITs, who in turn mentor campers. SIT-LITs have opportunities to personally get to know members of our summer staff.

Camp skills

SIT-LITs learn camp skills similar to what our summer staff members learn during their training. This helps prepare the SIT-LITs to be on summer staff some day.



2-Week Program

SIT-LITs commit to a 2-week training program in which they hone leadership skills and participate in adventure-based learning opportunities like high ropes and Voyageur canoeing. They also create a **leadership project**, to be led at their home congregation with aid from a mentor. During the 2 weeks, SIT LITs decide if they are interested in returning for the optional third week.

Choose from two sessions:

June 19-July 1

July 10-22

(SIT-LITs go home on the weekend in between weeks.)

Cost: \$395

The Third Week

SIT-LITs have an opportunity to come back to camp for a third week. This extra week does not cost extra, and it must be after they complete the 2 week training program. If SIT-LITs wish to return for a third week, they go through an application process that includes an interview. If they are chosen to return, they will be paired with a counselor in a cabin group for a week of leading games, songs, Bible study, worship, and more. This week of "shadowing" is extremely valuable to developing leaders.
