Program Committee Report

The year 2024 has been filled with exciting opportunities, meaningful connections, and continued growth in our ministry. Through our programs, we have witnessed God's presence drawing near to campers, families, and staff alike.

Program Director Deacon Stephanie humorously referred to 2024 as "the year of the Road Trip!" Sugar Creek staff traveled over 3,000 miles for summer staff recruitment and congregational visits. Along the way, they led lock-ins, worship services, intergenerational events, and more. These visits were important opportunities to share what God is doing in this sacred valley, be present with our partners in ministry, and express gratitude to all who make up the Sugar Creek family.

This intentional presence with our congregational partners has highlighted both the need and the opportunity for Sugar Creek to serve as a resource hub for ministry leaders—offering resources, consulting, and training. The program committee has been actively listening to our partners to discern how best to engage with emerging trends in Children, Youth, and Family Ministry. In 2025, this discernment will guide the committee in evaluating and enhancing year-round programming for people of all ages.

Sugar Creek's 2024 theme, "Created to Be," aligned with other Lutheran Outdoor Ministries and the ELCA Youth Gathering. Campers explored the God who created them to be free, authentic, brave, disciples, and disruptors. Both campers and summer staff experienced transformational growth, leaving with a deeper understanding that they were created with unique gifts to share. With an average of 29 summer staffers each week, this summer marked another strong step forward, moving beyond the lingering challenges of the pandemic. Encouragingly, returning staff rates for Summer 2025 indicate this positive trajectory will continue. Additionally, the LEAD (Leaders Engaged as Disciples) program for high school students remains a transformative experience, further strengthening the camper-to-staff pathway.

Executive Director Jesse Klosterboer and Dcn. Stephanie continue to work together to fine-tune summer programming. A key change this year was shifting the **Christ Hike** to Wednesday night, allowing campers a full day to reflect on the powerful retelling of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. This also allowed Thursday nights to transform into **Village Night**, a joyful celebration of relationships and memories. Each program area featured unique experiences, designed by Dcn. Stephanie and the Summer Leadership Team—from Root Beer Floats and Pioneer Olympics at Uncle Jack's to a meaningful bracelet ceremony for Rangers. Village Nights were a major success and created a fitting conclusion to the camp experience.

Looking ahead, the **2025 theme, "God's Word Draws Near,"** is based on Romans 10:8: "The word is near you, on your lips and in your heart." This theme will explore the expansiveness of God's love and timeless presence in our lives, with each day focusing on how God's Word draws near through worship, nature, relationships, and service.

Sugar Creek Bible Camp Minutes of 2024 Annual Meeting February 18, 2024

The 2024 Annual Meeting began with a devotion, 'Wrapped in God's Love,' offered by Pastor Lori Kleppe, where those gathered were reminded of the many ways guests at camp are embraced by God's love at Sugar Creek Bible Camp. The time of devotion continued as we sang 'All in All,' led by Jesse Klosterboer, Executive Director. The meeting continued with introductions of the Board of Directors and camp staff. Minutes of the 2023 Annual Meeting were approved.

Executive Director's Report

- The biggest obstacle to growth seems to be the lack of knowledge about the power of camp among the public and also many constituents. Hearing "I had no idea," as guests react to touring the facilities and hearing about programs, is what staff often hear when involved in outreach.
- Camper numbers were down this past season (down 15%) but staff numbers were improved from the previous year. International camp staff highlighted.
- Research shows empathy skills in young people have declined over the past decades but have been proven to be enhanced by a summer camp experience, so much so, they are at a 'pre cell phone' level.
- Dr. Jake Sorenson's research shows ELCA church leadership has been enhanced by young people who have had camp staff experience.
- 50,734 contact hours of Christian education provided by Sugar Creek this year.
- Sugar Creek Bible Camp had groups at camp 51 weeks out of the year.
- Jesse requests prayers that we are equipped in every way to do this ministry and thanked those
 in attendance for their support.

Committee Reports

Program Committee: Lindsay Colwell, Program Committee Chair, offered this report which highlighted the LEAD (Leaders Engaged As Disciples) program and its impact on a young person's faith development. Lindsay celebrated the growth shown in campers when they participate in activities back in their home congregations. A week-long day camp, a second tier of Jr. Wranglers, Trailblazers, Valley Olympics, and the HS Elevated program were mentioned as expanded offerings. The theme for the upcoming summer is 'Created to Be' based on Psalm 139 which goes along with the ELCA Youth Gathering theme.

Marketing and Development: Addison Arndt shared growth in the use of social media and that a tv commercial will go out on local stations. Electronic e-appeals were sent and resulted in a positive response. The camp website was updated. Largest and most important role is to spread the word about camp. Addison made a call for volunteers and that this support is welcomed. Jesse and Deacon Stephanie Engel, program director, will visit congregations to teach and preach as they spread the word of this ministry. Finally, Addison asked that we 'like and share' camp news on social media.

Property: Jody gave this report. The work of the Tuesday volunteers was highlighted and all of the staining work completed by that small crew. Thrivent Action cards were used to purchase the stain and Jody encouraged donating these cards for those with Thrivent accounts. The SIT-LIT Cabin is being renovated for use as housing for barn manager Miranda Arelt. This included adding a septic system, a kitchen, and a bathroom. The Saint Paul's log house is now being used as a rental as electricity and plumbing projects have been completed. Settler Cabins are receiving needed improvements and the goat prairie was burned. An invitation was made to everyone to participate in the volunteer weekend. Jody welcomes donations especially of construction materials. A thank you was offered to the volunteers who keep the camp up and running.

Executive: Bryce offered this committee as a sounding board for Jesse regarding financial reports, to set board agendas, and assist with personnel matters.

Sugar Creek Bible Camp Trust Foundation: Paul Arena, Treasurer of the foundation, directed attention to the report included in the packet. There were no questions for Paul. There is a need for membership on the Foundation Board.

Financials

- An audit of the records showed no concerns.
- Proposed 2024 Budget: Kristin Swedlund directed attention to the budget discussing various line items. Jesse explained comparisons with pre-pandemic numbers and funding of positions in the future.
- Motion to approve 2024 Financials made by Pastor Harald Bringsjord and second by Pastor John Twiton.

Elections

- The assembly was directed to the bios for candidates included in the packet. HR experience was an identified need which Katie Hunt would bring to the board. Jeff Mink, a retired plumber, offers his gifts to the board. No nominations were made from the floor.
- A motion for a unanimous ballot was made by Suzanne Bartels and a second by Kristin Swedlund.

Homework

Delegates were joyfully reminded of their stewardship call to care for camp, spread the word of *their* camp and invite others to share their gifts with Sugar Creek Bible Camp.

The 2024 Annual Meeting concluded with prayer and a prize drawing.
