Entering Grades 6-8 Cost: Tiered Pricing



Entering Grades 6-8 Cost: Tiered Pricing





- Remember – to help you with scheduling, interests, or bringing a friend/relative to the same program, you may enroll your camper "up or down" a year from what each program lists as the Grade Level, except for high school programs.

- Camp sessions generally begin Sunday with check-in from 2-4 pm, ending Friday with a closing program for families at 1 pm. Shorter programs (Explorers, Pilgrims, Family Camp) times vary.
- Sugar Creek reserves on a first-registered, first-reserved basis. Space is limited, so you can enroll early and change dates later. When schedule conflicts arise, stay in touch. We'll help this go as smoothly as possible. Call or email if you would like to arrange a payment plan.

Camper safety is our top priority! We follow hundreds of safety standards annually required for full ACA accreditation, including rigorous background checks and thorough training to ensure our Youth Ministry Staff are ready to provide a physically and mentally safe place for campers. Sugar Creek is a place where questions can be asked, and kids can be themselves.

+ Outdoors unplugged!

Healthy young people have quality time outdoors, unplugged from home, from screens, and other devices. Our programs get them in touch with creation in ways that lead to awe, respect, and curiosity. Meals, Bible study, worship times and other fun activities happen in God's beautiful outdoors!

+ Christ Centered!

Faith formation at Bible camp is a way of life, lived out in "holy play," caring conversations, and intentional times of worship, Bible study, and outside in God's wilderness – as much as during games and daily conversations about faith and life. Tiered Pricing

Sugar Creek believes all youth should have the opportunity to attend Bible Camp. We know camp families have differing abilities to pay, so we offer voluntary, Three-Tiered Pricing to better meet all financial needs. You self-select the rate you can afford! The actual price of a traditional camp program is approximately \$700/week. Therefore, we are offering the following rates this summer:
Tier 1 - \$695 (closest to the true cost of camp);
Tier 2 - \$495 (subsidized for families to make camp more affordable);
Tier 3 - \$395 (reflects more subsidies from fundraisers, churches, and camp supporters).

Families with three or more children attending camp can also receive a significant discount for each child after the first two. Please consider selecting the highest price you can afford as it helps more kids come to camp! Tier selected will not affect your child's camp experience. Tiered rates are shown on the Registration Form. Costs for Riverboats and Pilgrims have a set rate due to their unique program details.
