The Program Management Intern experiences creating and leading top-quality Christian retreat programs. With help from an experienced camp staff team, you will work alongside synods, congregations, and the wider Church through successful retreat ministries. The Intern assists the Program Director in planning adult and youth ministry programs. A primary responsibility is providing hospitality for meaningful community experiences for a variety of guests to develop hosting skills needed for program management. This internship is typically a 1-year position, concluding after the summer season. With God's help in this role you can inspire growth in Christian programming, vocational discernment in young adults, ministry support, volunteerism, and ultimately faith in the love of God through Jesus Christ.

- Serve with the Sugar Creek staff to plan, promote, and lead programs year-round
- Supervise the year-round coordination of a successful Day Camp (VBS) Program
- Lead program retreats for all ages, honing communication skills with guests, youth ministry staff, campers, and leaders
- Serve as host for retreat programs through hospitality for guest communities
- Build professional management experience by assisting with curriculum development, summer staff recruitment, hiring and supervision
- Be available as a "resource person" to lead parts of worship, team building, music, nature talks, campfires and other program activities (training provided)
- Imagine and create wild and relevant new program ministries for any ages
